

# THE YEAR IN

While the previous year might have been the first to finally wrest free from the last Covid restrictions, it still stood squarely under what will likely be at least a half decade long shadow. And while no sector has gone unscathed, the year that the New Zealand craft brewing industry endured was, to put it mildly, a rough one.



Prewers were initially seeing some relief as travel returned to normal and tourism picked up, but soaring materials costs and ballooning interest rates quickly stole back any ground they had managed to gain.

Amidst all these other hurdles, an additional boot to the ribs came as the country's supply of CO2 began to dwindle after the Kapuni plant (the only domestic producer of CO2) in Taranaki was forced to temporarily shut down the previous December, As supplies of this crucial gas ran dry, the price increased by over 500% in a single week as suppliers turned to imported stock.

For consumers, the wakeup call came in July with Epic Brewing (one of New Zealand's most popular craft beer brands) falling into liquidation. Similarly established brewers Deep Creek followed in November, and Brothers Beer just narrowly avoided the same fate. The sector is without a doubt contracting, and the question for 2024 will be by how much.

It's been an unprecedentedly tough year by all measures, but keep in mind that beer has been in demand since the dawn of civilization, it's nothing if not a resilient commodity. The industry may yet have some trials to overcome, but one way or the other New Zealanders will still be raising a glass, so there is light at the end of the tunnel.

Speaking of, and to steer away from all the doom and gloom, here are a few of my top standouts for 2023 that should still be available:

#### **EMERSONS: 'Taieri George 20th** edition' Spiced Ale 9.0%abv

An extremely special version of an extremely special beer. Taieri George is brewed once a year in remembrance of Richard Emerson's father George, and his commitment to the Taieri Gorge railway line (you can see how the original typo happened. A rare spiced ale, brewed with cinnamon, nutmeg and honey. This twentieth anniversary edition was boosted up to imperial strength.

#### PANHEAD: 'Supercharger X' Double APA 8.0%abv

Proving that the simplest answer is sometimes the best, Upper Hutt brewers Panhead Custom Ales have taken their titanically popular Supercharger American Pale Ale and doubled the recipe. It's the Supercharger you know, but bigger, heavier and hoppier than ever before.

#### BOOTLEG: 'Apehanger' IPA 6.3% abv

Hamilton's Bootleg Brewery have produced this NZ/US hybrid hopped IPA for over seven years now, and despite it being consistently one of my favourites, it always seemed to struggle to gain

mainstream attention. That all changed in 2023 when Apehanger delivered a mighty performance in both the Brewers Guild Awards and the New World Top-30.





#### Starsky and Hutch – Ford Gran Torino

As far as detective work goes, it pays to be subtle and not stick out like a sore thumb. However, it seems no one thought to tell detectives David Starsky and Ken "Hutch" Hutchinson as they rumbled around Bay City apprehending criminals in their 1974

Ford Gran Torino. Starsky and Hutch made household names of stars Paul Michael Glaser and David Soul, not to mention a cult following of that totally unsubtle and yet very cool Gran Torino.

Its bright red paint scheme and signature white stripe earnt it the nickname "The

Striped Tomato." Under the bonnet sat a 351 Cleveland V8 with a three-speed auto trans, but in later seasons this was replaced with a tyre shredding 400ci big block.

The site of Starsky sliding the Gran Torino around back alleys into the obligatory carboard boxes with tyres squealing and smoke billowing from under the Torino's skirt made for must see TV during the show's run from 1975 to 1979. It even led to many people doing the same red and white striped modifications to their car, even if the car in question was a Reliant Robin.



#### Magnum PI - Ferrari 308 GTS

Only Tom Selleck could make the combination of Hawaiian Shirts and a thick Moustache cool. Throw in a luxurious Hawaiian mansion, a stuffy ex-army sergeant-major running the place with a pair of Dobermans, a Ferrari 308 GTS, and you have Magnum Pl. Magnum Pl ran for nine seasons from 1980 to 1988 and catapulted Selleck to superstardom. He even graced the cover of New Zealand's first ever edition of TV Guide.

The show saw the plight of ex Naval Officer turned Private Investigator Thomas Magnum as he, and his friends TC and Rick, got involved in all manner of action-packed cases throughout the Hawaiian Islands. His vehicle of choice was his employer Robin Master's 1979 Ferrari 308 GTS, hence the number plate Robin 1.

Magnum was originally offered a Porsche 928, but this was rejected by producer Glen A Larson who opted for the glamour of the Ferrari instead. However, when production started, they found Selleck's 6ft 4 frame simply wouldn't fit inside it. The solution? Rip out all the seat padding, leaving Tommy basically sitting on the floor. Also, the roof was always off when he drove it.

The 308 would be upgraded throughout the show to the fuel injected GTSi and to the latter Quattrovalvole variants. While

there was plenty of fast Ferrari action throughout the shows run, there were more instances when the baddies in big wafting Cadillacs would manage to elude him during a chase. That aside, many of us wanted to be Magnum just to have a Ferrari to play whenever we wanted.

#### Knight Rider – 1982 Pontiac Trans Am

You can't leave this one out of the Top 4. Another Glen A Larson production, Knight Rider summed up the eighties obsession with futuristic technologies and acted as

KITT would be housed in the back of a Knight Industries 18-wheeler. This acted as a rolling laboratory for Michael's boss Devon Miles and assistants to ensure KITT had the latest crimefighting software and upgrades.

The show ran from 1982 to 1986, after which many fans went out to bag themselves a period Trans Am and turn it into a Knight Rider replica, complete with red light bar and correct interior. A few KITTs call New Zealand home so you might just see one.

Georgia, Bo and Luke would be jumping in through the window of the General Lee, a 1969 Dodge Charger complete with bull bars, confederate flag, a hefty 7.2L 440ci Magnum V8 producing around 375hp, and the now legendary '01' adorning each door. It was no secret both Bo and Luke dreamed of racing in NASCAR.

The General Lee spent most of its time either sideways on a dirt road or flying over a riverbed or Hazzard County Police cars, all narrated by Country Music legend Waylon Jennings. However, the General would be utterly totalled after landing each one of these spectacular jumps.

Of course, in the next shot, it would be totally fine. Legend has it that some fans of the show thought they could jump their Dodge Charger and drive off afterwards, with many finding out they couldn't the hard way.

Warner Bros destroyed so many 1968 to 1970 Chargers during production, they had a workshop with mechanics and panel beaters working around the clock to fix and repair wrecked General Lees. It got so bad that notes would be left on the windscreens of peoples Chargers from WB executives wanting to buy their cars.

Before he was a life guard running in slow motion all the time and a huge pop star in Germany, the "Hoff" played Michael Knight, a one-man crusader against injustice. His greatest weapon, a highly intelligent Pontiac Trans Am called the Knight Industries Two Thousand, or KITT.

KITT could drive himself, eject baddies from his cockpit, and even maintain intelligent conversation with Knight while out on one of their weekly missions. My partner, Jeannie & I recently competed in a barbecue cooking television show, similar to the Masterchef franchise, called Cooks of Fire. In the first challenge we were tasked to cook both "low n slow" and "hot n fast" style dishes.

So, we planned to cook one of our own personal "hot n fast" favourites reversed seared steak with a Roquefort blue cheese sauce and a medley of chargrilled seasonal veges. We have cooked this dish many times at home for friends and whanau and were confident that we would be able to pull it off in the time allowance of 30 minutes and that the judges would find the plate and flavours agreeable.

The cook went to plan and in the anxious moments whilst standing in front of barbecue royalty (the judges) the feedback was outstanding and the verdict was that we had "hit a home run!". We got praise for textures, doneness, and flavours, with one judge exclaiming "the blue cheese sauce, punched me in the face and I liked it!"



So thought I would share the method using some exquisite fellow deer back strap steaks - these can be substituted for mostly any cut of steak but flat iron, scotch and ribeye are particularly pleasing for steak connoisseurs.

#### **INGREDIENTS:**

2 x 100g Creamy Blue cheese 1 large white onion

2Tbsp White Wine (Sauvignon Blanc) 500ml Fresh Cream 100g butter



- In a pot on the stove, brown the butter
- Add finely chopped onion and sauté till soft and coloured.
- Add wine and gently reduce
- Add cheese and stir to smooth
- Add cream as required and reduce to required consistency..

- If present, trim away any silver skin or excess hard fat from the steak.
- Lightly season with salt and pepper

- Set your barbecue of choice up for indirect cooking (if unfamiliar with this technique, Google search your barbecue and "indirect" for help). Add some smoking wood splits - we use pohutukawa, but any fruit wood will pair well.
- Place the steak on to your barbecue indirect, close lid and have a beer!
- After approx 15mins and with a digital meat thermometer check steak and turn. Target internal temperature of the steak is 55c/130f for medium-rare doneness.
- Once the target temperature is achieved remove from the barbecue and wrap tightly in foil with butter for 10-15 minutes.
- Whilst the steak is resting get your barbecue cranking with plenty of

heat and flames for the final searing phase.

- Remove the steak from the foil and Remove the steak return every minute or so and remove when nice even dark crust is achieved.
- Slice the steak immediately, drizzle the blue cheese sauce over the top of the steak and serve with roasted (charred) vegetables of choice, or a fresh green salad.

It is hard to top a well-executed reverse seared steak with blue cheese sauce and is a crowd pleaser - even for the fussiest of judges! Z



Former Manu Samoa No 10 and freelance rugby scribe Campbell Burnes agrees that TMO overuse. at the international level, is ruining the game.

'm with Sir Steve Hansen.

The Rugby World Cup-winning coach and knight has called for rugby to do away with the TMO, or at least curtail its powers.

This follows, you'll recall, the most controversial final in Rugby World Cup history. It lasted two hours and five minutes from kickoff to no-side (!) and featured multiple interventions by TMO Tom Foley to 'help out' referee Wayne Barnes, who subsequently called time on his remarkable career.

There were some correct calls, some incorrect calls, some inconsistent calls. But as Hansen says, one certainly cannot lay the blame for how that final panned out at the feet of Barnes. We can for the infamous All Blacks' 2007 RWC quarterfinal defeat to France, or at least on World Rugby's referees boss of the time for

appointing such a green young official to such a pivotal clash.

Barnes missed a few things in the 2023 final, notably a raised elbow from Eben Etzebeth on Sam Cane. But he was still one of the top whistlers in world rugby.

The TMO was originally introduced to help the referee with contentious try rulings and later for foul play. The logic seemed sensible enough.

But now, as World Rugby runs scared from law suits by former players adversely affected by rugby-related concussions, they have gone too far in seeking to soften a dynamic and gladiatorial game that's very DNA is based on contact. Some will blame these former players, tacitly, of course, but World Rugby fears it will face ruination if it does not address player safety. While noble in theory, this stance is now alienating staunch rugby people and watchers and destroying the ability of new audiences to embrace rugby's appeal.

What you are left with is a game that takes too long to play, and is stop-start based on subjective decisions that many punters cannot even understand.

TMO rulings on high and/or dangerous tackles follow clear protocols, but those

protocols are completely subjective as every tackle is different. During the World Cup, if a player was put on report after being yellow carded, two foul play review officers went to work on ruling whether the yellow should be upgraded to red. So Sam Cane, whose high shot on Jesse Kriel was a clear yellow, found it upgraded to red. By the nature of how the officials are ruling these sort of tackles - shoulder to head it was the correct call. Strangely enough, the Siya Kolisi yellow for an accidental head clash with Ardie Savea, had more potential for injury as he ran hard from 10m away to clatter into the All Black. But, as I have maintained for two years, accidental head clashes should never incur yellow, let alone red, cards. They are accidents, even if the odd shoulder to the head is also an accident.

That is the maddening inconsistency we have in the game now. Far easier, as Hansen says, to strip the TMO of most of his power. Then we can get back to watching the game we love at the top level.

Failing that, just get along to watch your local club, old school or the NPC. That rugby is not subject to constant TMO interference and is over by the 90-95 minute mark, not two hours.

With almost 100-years of 'racing' history under its belt, we feel it's time to raise a glass to one of the most iconic racetracks in the world. Brands Hatch.

With its name being a derivative from the Gaelic term 'de Brondehach', and multiple racing disciplines, the circuit's unique combination of dips, cambers, fearsome corners and hills has made Brands Hatch more of an institution than a racetrack.

It all started in 1926 when a bunch of cyclists, led by Ron Argent, decided to take a break by a mushroom field off the London-Dover road after a 125-mile bike tour. Owned by Brands Hatch farm, (and once used for military training), Argent noticed the cool bowl-shaped terrain and asked the farmer if they could use its dirt roads to practise on.

1928 saw Brands Hatch have its first proper race, a four-mile match between cyclists and cross-country runners, the runners won, thanks to Australian

world champion runner Jackie Hobin. However, it was in 1947 (when Brands Hatch Stadium Ltd took charge), that the future for the track (and later the track itself) became sealed.

1950 saw the gates to Brands Hatch officially open, laying claim to being Britain's first post-war purpose-built racetrack.

In 1954, the circuit was reversed and Druids loop was added, pits and spectator banks were built and the facility began to take shape, but a potential setback occurred in 1961 when the land was sold to housing group Grovewood Securities. Thankfully 'Motor Circuit Developments' was created and things have barely slowed down since.

A defining moment in Brands Hatch's history occurred in 1964 when the Grand Prix layout was introduced. This 2.6-mile circuit quickly established itself as a challenging, high-speed circuit, demanding precision, skill, and bravery from the drivers. Over the years, it has played host to 12 Formula 1 Grand Prix events, with legends like Jim Clark, Jackie Stewart, and Ayrton Senna leaving their indelible mark on the circuit.

Paddock Hill Bend acquired a fearsome

reputation, claiming the lives of George Crossman, Tony Flory and Stuart Duncan, however, the death of Jo Siffert in 1971 spurred substantial safety enhancements, such as the introduction of debris fencing and tire barriers. These modifications were instrumental in preserving Brands Hatch's reputation as a world-class circuit.

The F1 GP was last staged in 1986, due in part to a multiple start line collision that seriously injured Jacques Laffite (fellow driver and eventual Brands owner Jonathan Palmer, a qualified doctor, coming to his aid). The open expanses of Silverstone were subsequently deemed more appropriate to the authorities.

In 2004, Hatch changed hands to MotorSport Vision, the facilities were spruced up and international events like the WTCC and DTM rolled in.

Today Brands Hatch symbolises motorsport excellence, a track that has withstood the test of time and maintained its relevance in a swiftly evolving world. It's a sanctuary for motorsport enthusiasts and a circuit that authentically captures the spirit and excitement of racing.

enerating extra distance is something most golfers obsess about. Increasing clubhead speed will deliver additional yardage however, there is no point in going at the golf ball 'harder' if when doing so your swing sequence breaks down. Ninetynine times out of a hundred 'accuracy' will outscore distance.

Increasing swing speed takes time – to do so you will need to strengthen your arms, legs and core as well as ensuring that you stay flexible. Be sure to continue hitting practice balls in between the strengthening of your muscles – this will help you to maintain your swing sequence which is critical to retaining accuracy.

Remember that a successful golf shot is one that hits the target (fairway or green)

I'm not suggesting that increasing the distances that you hit each club won't help - we'd all fancy our chances of hitting it closer to the flag with an 8 iron rather than

A question many pupils ask me is "Am I swinging too fast?"

A good gauge on whether you are swinging too fast will be if you are able to remain balanced throughout the entire golf swing.

There can be numerous reasons as to why amateur golfers will end up swinging the club too fast but pride is often the culprit.

- It could be because your partner has just cranked a long drive and you are trying to outdrive them.
- It could be that you are playing well and are feeling under pressure to keep your score going.
- You have selected a club that you know requires your 'Sunday best' strike to get there and as a result you end up forcing it.

To maintain your normal tempo, try this tip...

Count '1' when you start your swing, '2' at the top of your backswing, '3' at impact, and '4' at a balanced finish position.

This simple tip can help you maintain your tempo and prevent you from overthinking.
